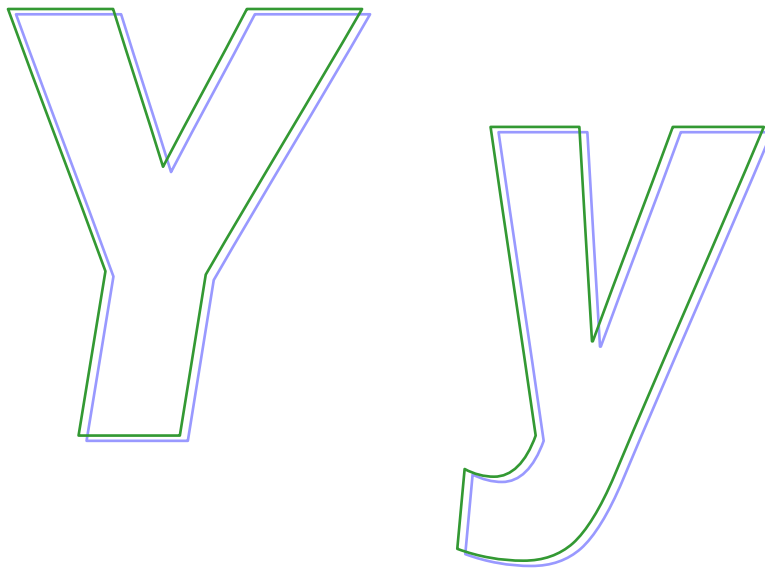

## Circle Time

### INTRODUCING LETTER Y DAY

#### Materials Included:

English & Spanish Word Wall Poster (pg 22-23)

Welcome Song (supplement file)

Weather & Calendar

#### You will need:

Circle Time (CT) Theme Bag—(Lg Gift Bag)

Items relating to today's theme

Place inside your CT theme bag one or all of the following: Pictures, books or items that relate to the days theme.

Gather the children for circle time, ask them to join you in the welcome song.

Hold up today's word wall poster and read each word as you explain it's meaning. Spell it out pointing to each letter. Ask the children to try to guess what the day's theme is. Allow each child opportunity to guess and share.

When the children are finished, ask them if you should look in the your CT theme bag to see. As you open the bag, lift out each item and ask the children to guess what it is, allow them opportunity for open discussion, sharing and observing. Pass each item around the circle for closer observation. Continue with your group discussion and stories.

Close your circle time activities by reading one of the suggested books from today's Story Time selections.

*During your quiet time, Insert your centers library card labels in your books and place them in your lending library for the children to check out on library check-out day.*

## Arts Crafts

### LETTER Y ART

**Materials Included:**  
Letter Y Outline

**You will need:**  
Old food magazines  
Scissors

Print out the letter Y outline for each child. Pass around the food magazines and have the children search for foods that are yummy to eat and foods that are yucky. Cut them out and glue them on the letter Y outline.

## Math Science

### TASTE TEST YUCKY-YUMMY

**You will need:**  
Foods that taste yucky (lemon, mushroom, onion, etc)  
Foods that taste yummy (apple, pear, bread & jelly, etc)  
Marker  
3-Paper plates

Use a marker and write Yucky on first paper plate and Yummy on a second paper plate. Arrange foods on a third paper plate that are yucky and yummy tasting when eaten. Invite the children to try them. Ask them to place the foods that taste yucky on the yucky plate and the yummy foods on the yummy plate. Discuss your findings.

### YUM YUM YAMS

#### Ingredients:

2 cans yams

2 apples (peeled/sliced)

5 Tbsp brown sugar

3 Tbsp Margarine

1/4 cup chopped nuts

1/4 Tsp nutmeg

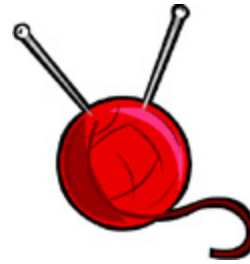
